- Received Technical Proposal shall be opened in the presence of Proponents' representatives who choose to attend at **14:30 P.M. on 13 August 2025** at the office of **AEPC/RERL, Khumaltar Height, Lalitpur**, Nepal.
- The method of selection will be Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS), **80:20** weightage for Technical and Financial proposals respectively.
