- 1. Expression of Interest may be submitted by a sole firm or a joint venture of consulting firms.
- 2. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (descriptions, organization and employee and of the firm or company, description of assignments of similar nature completed in the last 7 years and their location, experience in similar conditions, general qualifications and the key personnel to be involved in the proposed assignment).
- 3. This expression of interest is open to all eligible consulting firm.
- 4. In case, the applicant is individual consultant, details of similar assignment experience, their location in the previous 4 years and audited balance sheet and bio data shall be considered for evaluation.
- 5. The assignment has been scheduled for a period of Four Months. Expected date of commencement of the assignment is 14-04-2022.
- 6. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the QCBS method.

Terms of Reference for Feasibility Study of Carbon Neutral Village

1. Introduction

Alternative Energy Promotion Centre (AEPC) is a Government institution established on 3 November 1996 with the objective of developing and promoting renewable and alternative energy technologies in Nepal. Currently, it is under the Ministry of Energy, Water Resources and Irrigation. AEPC is mandated for the promotion and development of renewable energy, energy efficiency and climate change activities. It has good experience in formulation of the climate change and carbon related projects in Nepal.

AEPC has been implementing various programs with the mission to make renewable energy a mainstream resource through increased access, knowledge and adaptability contributing for the improved living conditions of the people and with the vision to develop an institution recognized as a regional/international example of promoting large-scale use of sustainable renewable energy and a national focal point for resource mobilization.

2. Background

AEPC established a dedicated Climate and Carbon Unit (CCU) in 2010. This unit is responsible for coordinating renewable energy and energy efficiency related climate change mitigation and adaptation activities at a national and local level. It works to identify and develop Nepal's portfolio of renewable energy related carbon projects (both CDM and voluntary markets) and responsible to handle the activities to develop the project concepts and proposals for Green Climate Fund (GCF) and other international climate funds to increase an access to international climate finance. At present, AEPC is planning to develop the carbon neutral village to demonstrate the implementation of carbon neutrality concept. Basically, the concept of carbon neutral means maintaining balance between emissions of carbon and absorption of carbon from the atmosphere. Similarly, the Second Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) has envisioned that by 2030 at least five tourist destination will be carbon neutral. Nepal being a less contributor of GHG emission, there are many places within the country, which can adopt this carbon neutrality concept and expand/replicate to other areas of Nepal.

3. Rational

There are different potential areas in the country, which can be transformed into the carbon neutral place. Such potential carbon neutral places will be the best project site for the implementation of the AEPC renewable energy programs. For this, it is important to identify these potential areas and carry out feasibility study. Understanding this need of study, AEPC is planning to hire a consulting firm to carry out the feasibility study for developing to carbon neutral village.



4. Objectives

The main objective of this study is to identify the potential project sites and conduct the feasibility study to know the potentiality of project sites to transform into Carbon Neutral Village. The proposed areas from the study shall be appropriate locations to implement the AEPC renewable energy activities. The other specific objectives of this study are to:

- Understand the existing carbon foot print of different activities in the areas
- Calculate Green House Gases (GHGs) emission from different sources
- Identify the various potential renewable energy technologies to reduce and absorb GHGs emission and climate adaptation measures
- Find the balance between emitting carbon and absorbing carbon
- Propose suitable renewable energy technologies to reduce the GHGs emission

5. Scope of Work

The scope of feasibility study shall include but not necessarily be limited to the following:

- Prepare criteria/checklist to identify potential area for carbon neutral village/cluster
- Identify the two most potential areas in different part/geographical region of the country in coordination with respective local government which can be transformed into model carbon neutral village
- Describe existing condition /baseline study of the proposed project areas
- Detail out list of all the activities in the area and its carbon foot print
- Identify ways/means to transform potential areas towards low energy, low carbon and highly resilient ultimately resulting to climate neutral village.
- Propose the model to move towards net zero emissions of GHGs
- Identify the vulnerable groups and its location and propose the physical and social protection measures
- Proposed the different types of less emitting transportation/mobility facilities to reduce the GHG emission
- Planning of the areas with the aim to protect carbon sequestration hotspots like forest and animal habitat and calculate the rate of carbon sequestration
- Environment and social assessment of project activities for transforming into carbon neutral village
- Conduct stakeholder consultation to understand the willingness of the people to adopt the carbon neutrality concept
- Propose the sustainable methods of waste utilization and recycling methods that reduces the GHG emission, and
- Prepare/compile existing data of renewable energy technologies and estimate the cost for potential renewable energy technologies (cooking, lighting and other proposes) for making these areas for carbon neutral village.

6. Reporting Obligations

The Firm should submit following reports to the AEPC concerned staffs



- Three copies of inception report (color) shall be submitted within the seven (7) days from the contract agreement.
- Three copies on draft comprehensive reports (color) shall be submitted prior to the presentation within (3.5) two and half month from the signing of contract
- Three copies of final report (color) after incorporation of comments and suggestions shall be submitted within the contract period (Three (4) month from the date of contract signing).

7. Estimate Time Duration

The firm is expected to complete whole task **within Four (4) months** from the date of signing contract agreement.

8. Term of Payment

- 30% of the contract value after submission of inception report with detail work plan including field visit plan
- 50% percent after submission of draft report
- Remaining amount after the presentation and acceptance of final report comments.

9. Qualification of the Consulting Firm

- The consultant must have extensive experience in conducting such type of study in the past and have adequate knowledge on large biogas technologies.

Master Degree in Climate Change/Environmental Engineering/ Environmental Science/ Environment Management/ Natural Resource Management or other relevant field. The expert must have at least Seven (10) years of work experience in climate change adaptation and mitigation projects and environmental assessment (Brief Environment Study (BES)/ Initial Environment Examination (IEE)/ Environment Impact Assessment (EIA)) of the renewable energy projects.

• Financial Expert

Master degree in Business Administration/Business Studies/Commerce/accounting or other relevant field. The expert must have at least Seven (7) years of work experience on climate finance, climate change adaptation and mitigation projects, renewable energy incentive schemes and must have good experience of cost estimation and budgeting of climate and renewable energy projects.

• Social Expert

Master degree in Social Science/Anthropology/Sociology/Rural development or other relevant field. The expert must have at least Seven (7) years of work experience on climate change adaptation and mitigation projects and work experience of social expert in environment assessment (Brief Environment Study (BES)/ Initial Environment Examination (IEE)/ Environment Impact Assessment (EIA)) of the renewable energy projects.

• Renewable Energy Expert

Master's Degree in energy, electrical engineering, mechanical engineering or other relevant field at least Seven (7) years of work experience in the energy planning and designing of the renewable energy system, including work experience of emission reducing renewable energy technology for climate change mitigation projects


